

- The manuscript is not concurrently submitted to other journals.
- The manuscript is arranged in following order: Title page, Abstract, Keywords, Main text, References, Table legends, and Figure legends
- Font of the main text is 10–point size.
- Corresponding author name, address, E–mail, and ORCID in title page.
- Information on the name(s) and affiliation(s) of the author(s) is not disclosed in the manuscript except the title page.
- Research or project support/funding and conflict of interest statement should be noted on the title page.
- The title should not exceed 50 characters for Korean, 35 words for English.
- The abstract should not exceed 250 words for original articles and 200 words for case reports.
- Keywords (less than 5) are provided (should be inserted in the submission step).
- Manuscript should not exceed 3,000 words for original articles, 5,000 words for review article, and 1,500 words for case reports, excluding references.
- All human and animal studies are approved by an Institutional Review Board.
- Tables, graphs, and drawings are brief and self–explanatory.
- Each title of the tables, graphs, and drawings is also self–explanatory.
- All tables and figures are uploaded in a separated file.
- Table footnotes should use these symbols: *, †, ‡, §, ||, ¶, **, ††, and †††.
- The number of tables should not exceed seven.
- Figures are separated from figure legends.
- Figure resolutions are higher than 600 dpi.
- The number of references should not exceed 40 for original articles, 60 for review article, and 10 for case reports.
- References are in the correct style.
